

# Fall Opening Precautions

- 8:30 Teachers arrive for temperature checked and daily health observation (which I just updated my certification on)
- 8:50 the two-year old classroom will arrive for temperature checks and daily health observation
- 9:00 the three-year old classroom will arrive for temperature checks and daily health observation
- 9:10 the four-year old classroom will arrive for temperature checks and daily health observation
- Sanitizer will be given to the children after exiting the car and children will wash hands when entering classroom.
- Numbers per classroom: (ages as of 2020/2021 school year)
  - 2s-no more than 8 children
  - 3s-no more than 10 children
  - 4s-no more than 15 children (maybe only 10)
  - 4s-no more than 12 children (maybe only 10)
  - One/two teachers per classroom (hopefully two)
  - Diana will float to help teachers
- Outside time: We will be in thirty-minute intervals (only one class at a time) with ten minutes for sanitizer.
  - The teachers will sanitize the playground equipment after each group.
- The bathrooms (including adult restroom) will be cleaned by Diana twice in the morning, once in the afternoon and when the children leave. We will be installing automatic soap dispensers in the bathrooms.
- As of right now we will not have music (Ms. Claire) or chapel (Pastor Alex). We will reevaluate this in October.
- The classroom will have limited number of chairs so the children can social distance while sitting. Activities will be done in small groups with some social distancing while sitting at tables.
- The classrooms/equipment/toys will be cleaned daily and certain items will be cleaned between use. The fours will have pencil boxes for crayons, markers, and pencils. In the twos and threes, the teachers will monitor the use of individual supplies.

- Children will have their own hook and cubby for the personal items (coats, bags, folders, snacks, and lunches.)
- The teachers will wear masks/face shields as often as possible (not outside).
- If parents would like their children to wear a mask, we will help with the children keeping them on. The children are not required to wear a mask.
- The teachers will be cleaning their classroom/equipment/toys as needed throughout the day.
- Handwashing will be increased for the children and teachers.

- Any parent coming in the building will be required to wear a face mask, temperature check and hand sanitizing before entering building.
- Parents will also have to sign a COVID release and a COVID liability. It will state that no one in the household has been diagnosed or experiencing any symptoms of the coronavirus.
- We will only follow WJCC for holidays. We will follow the Department of Social Services (DSS) for childcare and any orders from the governor.
